

Internet Access Policy

Waterford Libraries cannot guarantee the accuracy of information accessed, nor can they accept responsibility for, or supervise content, that maybe viewed inadvertently or otherwise by a user. The Library accepts no responsibility for damage, loss, costs or digital security issues arising either directly or indirectly from use of the Library's free Internet-based computer services, whether using fixed PC or Wi-Fi service in branches.

All users are required to read and accept the Library's **Free Internet Access Acceptable Use Policy** below before using the service.

Free Internet Access Acceptable Use Policy:

- Access to the Internet is available to all current registered Waterford Libraries members.
- Internet sessions on PCs may be pre-booked in advance. The Wi-Fi service can be accessed at any time during opening hours.
- Bookings for PCs may only be made for one session per day.
- Bookings not taken up within 10 minutes will be forfeited.
- Members of the library must be able to present their library card when asked by staff.
- Sessions must be used by the member booked in.
- The service is provided in a shared social space where respect and consideration must be shown towards other library users.
- Users are automatically logged off at the end of a session.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and sites accessed are the sole responsibility of parent or guardian.
- Young people aged between 12 and 16 may use the Internet unaccompanied, provided a parent or guardian has authorised such use on application form.
- Users may not create, access, store, transmit, download or publish any material that:
 - Is pornographic, obscene, racist, defamatory or illegal
 - Causes harassment or gross offence to others
 - Constitutes a breach of copyright laws or licensing agreements
- Waterford Council network restrictions may apply on some services as required by digital security policies.
- Users should also be aware that all sites accessed on the public network are retained for a period of time.
- Users are responsible for their own online account security.

Users who fail to observe the above conditions will immediately be logged out and denied access to Internet facilities.
