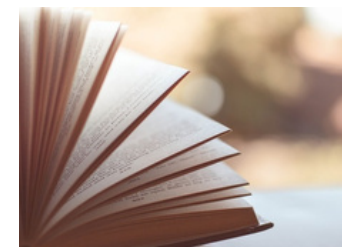

# Become a Member:

It's free to join the library, and creating an account is easy. Just follow these steps:



Fill out a library membership form.  
- Staff will help you fill one out in branch or you can fill in the online form at:

Bring some Photo Identification and Proof of Address when you visit to join.  
- Drivers Licence, Passport, Utility Bill etc.

Young people under 18 years old need Parent / Guardian permission to join.

# Borrowing Items:



**Borrow:**  
**12 Items**



**Keep For:**  
**3 Weeks**

- Renew items on loan up to 3 times, subject to availability.
- No fines are charged for late returns.
- Reminders and Notices are sent by email.
- Items overdue 9 weeks or longer are considered lost and borrowing privileges will be removed.
- Borrowing privileges cannot be restored until either the overdue item is returned, or contact has been made with a library staff member to discuss the matter.
- Fees for lost /damaged adult items will be charged and are shown as a balance on a library account.

# Computers & Internet:

Use a computer, internet or WiFi in the library for free with your library account.



Browse the internet on our computers or on your own device using the Library WiFi.



Computers in the library have lots of useful programs installed like Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel and Microsoft Powerpoint

To access a library computer you need your **Library Card** and **PIN** details. **Free WiFi** is also available.

# Printing, Photocopying & Scanning Services:



Self Service Printing, Photocopying & Scanning services are available.

You can also email documents to a printer in the library from home and collect and pay for your prints within the next 72hrs.

- Print, Photocopy and Scan up to A4 size.
- Black & White Printing costs €0.20c per page
- Colour Printing costs €0.60c per page
