On PC / MAC:



- Visit the library online at: www.waterfordlibraries.ie and click on Online Resources from the top menu, then choose the eBooks & eAudiobooks link.
- Sign in with your library card number and pin number.
- Browse and select a title.
- Confirm ebook loan.
- If you don't have Adobe Digital Editions installed you will need to do this now. Click on Download it Now.
- Once Adobe Digital Editions is installed you can then return to the download page and click on Download for eReader (Adobe ePub).
- Adobe Digital Editions should open automatically and you can start reading your book.

On Tablets / Smartphones:
